



Clive Holtham CV Professor Clive Holtham: Professor of Information Management, Cass Business School, City, University of London since 1988; Director of Cass Learning Laboratory since 2002. He unusually combines a business background in accounting, technology and systems thinking with active development of arts-based initiatives in management and research.

Knowledge Management: This research not only covers the use of information technology to stimulate creativity within organisations, including his design of the 21st Century Boardroom for the West London TEC, but evolved into a concern with the use of physical and mental spaces to promote creativity .

Virtual Collaboration: He has been working since the late 1980's on innovative approaches to high engagement electronic community collaboration. He was a co-founder of Knowhownonprofit.org (Big Lottery Fund, £2.1m online informal learning project) and in particular was main

sponsor of its innovative on-line management soap opera.

Leadership for innovation: Since 2005 he has led an MBA elective called “The Art of Management”, which examines business themes through the lens of different fine arts. Co-founder of the City University Centre for Creativity in Professional Practice and its innovative Masters in Innovation, Creativity and Leadership (2010)
