He is passionately involved in activities as Editor-in-Chief in the Journal “Economics of Contemporary Russia” (“*Ekonomicheskaya nauka sovremennoy Rossii*”), as Deputy Editor-in-Chief in the Journal “Russian Journal of Management” (“*Rossiyskiy jurnal menedjmenta*”) and as the Member of Editorial Boards in the Journal “Economics and Mathematics Methods” (“*Economica i Matematicheskie Metodi*”), “Montenegrin Journal of Economics” and others.
