



**Alfonso Reyes** is a physicist and a system engineer from Los Andes University in Colombia. He has an MSc in Computer Science (University of Maryland at College Park), a PhD in Management Cybernetics (University of Humber in England) and postdoctoral studies in Organizational Learning (University of Lincoln in England).

He has worked for the last thirty years in addressing organisational problems in the public sector especially in the administration of justice. He is a former adviser of the Ministry of justice in Colombia and was the chairman of a governmental Committee proposing normative recommendations to improve the administration of Justice to be included in the Colombian Constitution in 1991. He has been an international consultant for the Interamerican Development Bank and the Agency for International Development (USA) in applying management cybernetics to the public sector.

He is co-author of four books and has published several papers about individual learning, organisational learning and self-regulation from the

point of view of second-order cybernetics.
