



Bernard Scott has the honorary position of Gordon Pask Professor of Sociocybernetics at the International Center for Sociocybernetics Studies, a virtual institute with headquarters in Bonn, Germany. Previously he was Head of the Flexible Learning Support Centre, UK Defence Academy, and Reader in Cybernetics, Cranfield University, UK. He is a Fellow and founder member of the Cybernetics Society, an Associate Fellow of the British Psychological Society, a Fellow of the American Society for Cybernetics and an Academician of the International Academy of Systems and Cybernetics Sciences.

Professor Scott has been a member of Research Committee on Sociocybernetics (RC51) of the International Sociological Association since 1996, serving as President 2006-2010. Professor Scott served as editor of the *Journal of Sociocybernetics* (2002-2006) and of the journal *Interactive Learning Environments* (2004-2008). He is a member of the editorial advisory boards of the journals *Kybernetes*, *Cybernetics and Human Knowing*, *International Journal of Information and Learning Technology* and *Constructivist Foundations*. Dr Scott has more than 130 academic publications to his credit.
