

**Alenna Leonard, Ph.D.** is an American/Canadian consultant in organizational cybernetics based in Toronto. Her academic background includes a BA from St. John's College, a MA from George Washington University and a Ph.D. from the University of Maryland. She is a licensee of Team Syntegrity, a director of the Cwarel Isaf Institute and vice-chair of the Ecologos Environmental Institute.

Beginning in the 1980's and continuing until his death, she worked with Stafford Beer on a variety of consulting and educational projects in North America, South America and Europe. the most prominent being Projecto Urucib in Montevideo Uruguay for the UNDP. Her interests include improving accountability measures for soft information and applications of cybernetics to governance and ecology.

She has taught university courses and published numerous papers and articles. Much of her work has been focused on the use of Beer's Viable System Model and Team Syntegrity Process. She is a past president of the American Society for Cybernetics, and received it's McCulloch Award and is a past president of the International Society for Systems Science.

She continues to support and extend Beer's work in Conference presentations and by volunteering with Metaphorum, the organization founded to continue his legacy.
